2019 Q2 MUSICIAN-IN-RESIDENCE RFP

Request for Proposals

Gordon Square Arts District (GSAD) is now accepting proposals from musicians for the Q2 Gordon Square Musician-in-Residence session. Open to musicians, of all disciplines and genres. The selected proposal will include at least one free outdoor performance in the Gordon Square neighborhood, and descriptions of intended community engagement through music, and how the musician-in-residence plans to utilize the people and places of Gordon Square and infuse the neighborhood with vibrant creative activity.

Eligible Disciplines

Musicians, vocalists, songwriters, bands, ensembles, DJ's, and producers of all disciplines, genres and instruments are invited to submit proposals.

Duration

This residency will take place Q2 of 2019, from April 1st to June 30th.

Stipend

GSAD will support the chosen musician-in-residence with a \$5,000 artist stipend and project costs up to \$2,000.

Deadline

Applications and all related materials are due via email to art@gordonsquare.org by 12:00pm Noon on Tuesday, January 1st, 2019

Review Process

A committee of arts professionals and GSAD board members will review proposals by the following criteria:

- Artistic quality of proposed project
- Professional artistic experience of applicant
- Clear artistic engagement with Gordon Square community
- Inclusion of at least one free outdoor performance in the Gordon Square neighborhood
