Request for Proposals

Gordon Square Arts District (GSAD) is now accepting proposals from visual artists for the Q3 Gordon Square Artist-in-Residence session. Open to visual artists of all disciplines and mediums, the selected proposal will include descriptions of intended community engagement through visual art, utilize the people and places of Gordon Square and infuse the neighborhood with vibrant creative activity.

Eligible Disciplines

Visual Artists of all disciplines and mediums are invited to submit proposals.

Duration

This residency will take place Q3 of 2019, from July 1st to September 30th.

Stipend

GSAD will support the chosen artist-in-residence with a \$5,000 artist stipend and project costs up to \$2,000.

Deadline

Applications and all related materials are due via email to art@gordonsquare.org by 12:00pm Noon on Tuesday, January 1st, 2019.

Review Process

A committee of arts professionals and GSAD board members will review proposals by the following criteria:

- Artistic quality of proposed project
- Professional artistic experience of applicant
- Clear artistic engagement with Gordon Square community


